STAGE 3 WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

July 6, 2021

Please use water sparingly in the Lyall Harbour – Boot Cove Water System.

The Lyall Harbour – Boot Cove Water System source water resources are reaching critical levels. Due to the current hot and dry conditions, and the sensitivity of your water source we are seeking your cooperation to reduce water usage for everyone's benefit. To avoid trucking in water, please continue to use water sparingly until water resource levels recover.

Residents are required to conserve water as follows:

- No watering of lawns.
- Limited watering of trees, shrubs and vegetables with container or hose with shut-off valve.
- No washing of outdoor surfaces such as driveways, sidewalks and decks.
- No washing of vehicles and boats.

What else can you do?

- Use mulch to keep the moisture in the ground around plant beds, trees and shrubs.
- Recycle water wherever you can: install water catchment systems, keep pails and buckets handy to catch extra water.
- Remind tenants, visitors and guests of the need to conserve water with shorter showers.
- Avoid potential water loss catastrophes by shutting off the water at the main when leaving town for more than a day.
